About Preliminary Hearing Waivers: A preliminary hearing waiver means the defendant formally gave up the right to a preliminary hearing. It is not a finding of guilt or a sentence. The waiver generally concludes the lower court's preliminary handling of the case and allows the case to proceed to the appropriate higher trial court for further proceedings.

About Prosecutor Dismissals: Dismissed by the Prosecutor means the prosecuting authority ended the listed charge or case. It is not a finding of guilt.
